

February Accomplishments

Aquatics:

- The Atwater Splash pad and NPAC Pelican Playground both were resurfaced.
- The Barracuda Blast trap door was replaced.
- Hired 23 new seasonal employees for Spring break and summer operations.

Recreation:

- Kids Night Out hosted 15 children who did Groundhog Day themed activities and crafts while learning about the history of the day.
- Community Yard Sale and Newcomers Day each had over 500 attendees and were at the maximum for vendors and businesses.
- Woofstock, at its new location at Butler Park, let 475 dog lovers have a tail wagging good time with over 20 vendors, canine demonstrations, and lots of four legged friends ready for adoption. Recreation was able to donate over 50 dog food supply items to Rescue Garage.

Maintenance:

- Warm Mineral Springs got a makeover with pressure washing, installation of new fence rope, new plants, newly mulched landscaped beds, plus the removal, repair, and reinstallation of one of the walk-in entrance ramps into the spring.
- All athletic fields were fertilized.
- New safety netting was installed on the first base side of Narramore softball field 2 and along the third base side of field 1.
